Hunting Permission Process:

Hunting on Springville Field and Stream Club property is allowed for members only. All club members must carry a card provided by the Board of Directors in order to hunt on Club property. This card and required forms must be obtained from a Club officer or Club director prior to hunting on Club property. The hunting privilege card is good for 1 year from date of issue.

These hunting privilege cards and required forms are available at the general membership or director's meetings on a monthly basis. Revocation or suspension of some or all Hunting privileges for some or all members may occur at any time providing a majority vote of the Board of Directors.

Board of Director's Regulations:

- 1. Hunting and range use will not occur at the same time on club property.
- 2. All hunters must have a signed release of Liability form on record before hunting on club property.
- 3. Range open and Range Closed sign must be used at all times at the range. (EX. Sign must read range closed if you are hunting)
- 4. Hunters must read, sign a declaration and carry a card from the board that they will follow all club rules when hunting on club property. This form is valid for 1 year from date of signature.
- 5. Hunting and range used during small game and big game season will be on a first come first served basis.
- 6. No hunting during the last two weekends before firearm big game season. This allows club members a weekend to sight in their firearms before big game season opens.

Rules for Hunting on Club Property:

- 1. Club members only may hunt on club property.
- 2. Blaze orange is required to be worn by all hunters other than those taking part in bow hunting, waterfowl and/or turkey hunting.
- 3. Range Open and Range Closed sign must be used at the range pavilion. Before hunting the range-use sign must be flipped to say Range Closed and last hunter to leave is to flip it back to Range Open. Put name and phone number on whiteboard for emergency contact, erase when done.
- 4. Hunting under the influence of alcohol is prohibited.
- 5. Firearms are to be fired in a safe direction only.
- 6. Firearms are to never be pointed at people, buildings or vehicles on club property.
- 7. Firearm muzzle is to be pointed in safe direction at all times.
- 8. All empty/used shells/brass/arrows are to be removed from club property daily.
- 9. No hunting from inside the main cabin or from under the front porch area.
- 10. The use of portable and permanent tree stands is prohibited.
- 11. Must park in club house parking lot. Leave the main gate open and unlocked.
- 12. No physical confrontations are allowed on club property.
- 13. Failure to follow these rules for hunting on club property can result in hearing before the Board of Directors and revocation of club membership privileges.
- 14. Club members must carry the club's hunting privilege card with them at all times to hunt on club property.

Cabin and Grounds Rental Fee Schedule 2025

The Board of Director's voted at the October Board Meeting to adopt the following fee schedule for rentals starting January 1, 2025:

- Basic Cabin Rental weekend members \$200.00 per day non-members \$250.00 per day
- Basic Cabin Rental weekday members \$150.00 per day non-members \$200.00 per day (includes use of cabin, kitchen facilities and picnic pavilion).
- Add Service Building use to Basic Cabin Rental for an additional \$100.00 per day
- Add Use of range for purposes of business teaching a firearm training course is the basic cabin rental fee
 noted above plus an additional \$150.00 per day. Must have business insurance information on file with the
 Board.
- All fees and deposits are payable by personal/business check only. No cash or money-orders accepted.
